

LITTLE CRUM CREEK PARK STORYBOOK WALK

Changing several times a year, the Storybook Walk has 18 stops on a paved and grass path that illustrates a children's book chosen by the Swarthmore Public Library. An easy, fun walk for all ages with an opportunity for a picnic lunch near the creek!

Themes: Nature, Kid Friendly

Amenities: Creek Views, Woods, Benches, Picnic Tables, Interpretive Panel

Surfaces: Paved, Grass, 0.3 miles long

Slope: Mostly flat, 13 ft elevation gain

Hazards: Wet Grass, Ponding, Mud, Roots

Emergencies: Call 911

Difficulty Rating: Easy Stroll: I walk infrequently, though I'd like to do more. I want to see new things, but not very far off the beaten (i.e. paved) path. A few rises here or there might be OK, but no steep paths or sidewalks, please.

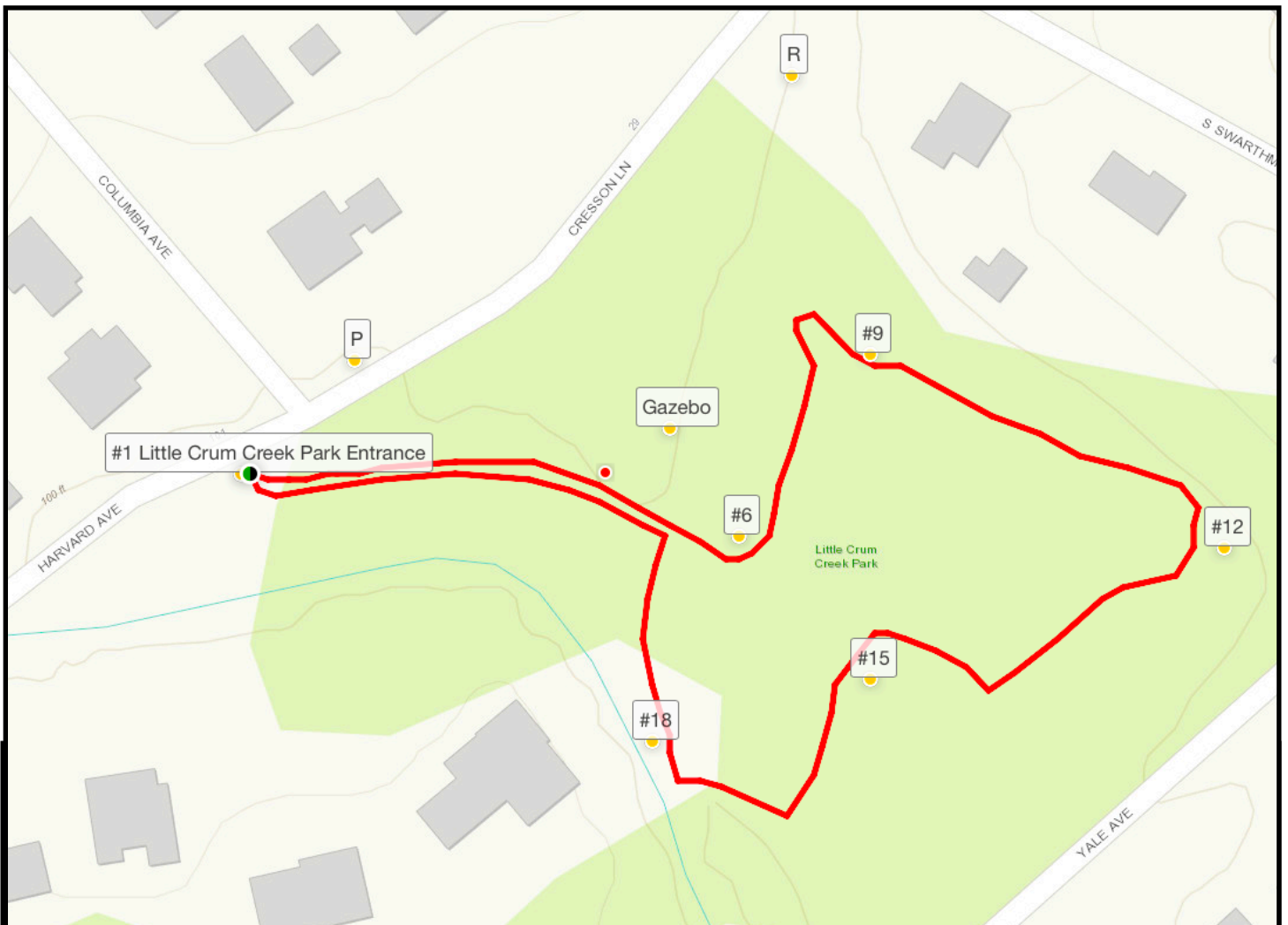
Resource(s) shown on the map:

Waypoints shown on the map:

Little Crum Creek Park

Entrance: SStorybook Sign Panel #1. (Nearby, a dog bag station and trash receptacle.)

Gazebo: The gazebo has benches overlooking the creek. Watch out for roots in the asphalt path.

Sign #6. After crossing the bridge, Storybook Sign Panel #6 is slightly hidden to the left of the path.

Sign #9. Storybook Sign Panel # 9

Sign #12: After stopping at Storybook Sign Panel #12, avoid a low area that is subject to ponding just past Panel #14.

Sign #15: Storybook Sign Panel # 15.

Sign #18: Storybook Sign Panel #18 is located on a mulch path that has a bench next to the creek.
