June 28, 2016

Little Crum Creek Park:

Continue to look for ways to improve and enhance the Park. Looking to continue Pop Up Art in the Park; add electricity to support Park uses; bring Dance Group to the Park in September (which will involve bringing a grant to fund various expenses for the program); DelCo Debates on September 17th (Constitution Day) may occur in the Park; Makers Market (coordinated with Lora Pietrangelo, Town Center Coordinator) is possible; and the Library has proposed a Story Walk (19 stands in the lower portion of the Park), in anticipation of fundraising events over the winter, hopefully with a spring installation.

John Crawford is working on building benches and picnic tables for his Eagle award.

Need coordination with SRA and Dave Murphy on Horseshoe Tournament and repairs to Park afterward.

Question on scheduling Fall Clean-up.

Still need to coordinate tree removal for downed trees.

Need to coordinate on milkweed planting along fence line.
