

MEETING NOTICE

APPLICATION FOR LAND DEVELOPMENT

Swarthmore College has applied to the Borough of Swarthmore for approval of a Final Land Development application for construction of a new 158,925 square foot (35,739 square foot footprint) academic building to be located approximately 500 feet south of the north entrance to the Swarthmore College campus at Elm Avenue and Whittier Place, near the existing Swarthmore Friends Meeting House and Pearson, Beardsley, Papazian, and Hicks Halls, along with related improvements. Papazian and Hicks Halls will be demolished for construction of the new building. The proposed building is located in the IN-A Institutional Zoning District. Required Conditional Use approval was granted by Swarthmore Borough Council on December 5, 2016.

The application will be reviewed and discussed at the Swarthmore Planning Commission meeting on Wednesday, February 15, 2017 beginning at 7:30 p.m. in the Council Room of Swarthmore Borough Hall, located at 121 Park Avenue in Swarthmore, PA.

A copy of the application is available for review at the Borough Office and the Swarthmore Public Library.
